Math	Multiplication; <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Up to 9×9- Whole numbers by 10, 100, 1000- 2 digit by 1 digit using the traditional algorithm Division; <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Up to $81 \div 9$- Whole numbers by 10 and 100 (ex. $450 \div 10 = 45$)- 2 digit by 1 digit using skip counting, fact families and grouping-
Language	Reading: Inferencing; using text or pictures clues plus our schema to find out what's happening, how someone is feeling, what the meaning is...etc. Writing: We chose our topics for our speeches that we will be presenting in April.
