A Peek At Our Week

Math: This week we explored the creation and identification of patterns in 100s charts and sequentially. We learnt to identify growing, shrinking and repeating patterns. We also explored how to translate patterns.

Language: Students are generating and organizing ideas using various charts. In reading, our focus is on making connections as we read (text to self, text to text and text to world).

Science: This week we investigated the needs of the Beaver in its habitat and compared it to our own habitat.

SOCIAL Studies: In Social Studies this week we investigated different centers based on the hierarchy during Medieval Times.

Health & DE: In our swimming lesson this week we learnt that swimming takes a little coordination.
